Eligible businesses must meet the following criteria:

- Eligible positions must meet Florida minimum wage requirements
- Employee worksite location must be in Hillsborough County
- Eligible businesses must be for-profit businesses in Hillsborough County
- In operation for at least one year
- Businesses must have suffered economic impact due to the COVID-19 outbreak

The goal of the webinars is to provide Hillsborough County employers with information on the benefits of the Rapid Response Recovery Program (R3), and how they can allow CSTB to help expand the skilled workforce in Hillsborough County in the areas of most need.
