ELIGIBILITY

Veterans, Military Spouses and Transitioning Service Members who will be on Terminal Leave by May 1st, 2022.

REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Must be on terminal leave or separated so they will be an Airborne employee
- ✓ Will have or expect an "other than dishonorable" discharge
- ✓ Will have at least 2 years on-aircraft experience (first round only)
- ✓ Will be able to pass appropriate level Background Investigation
