- Up to 40 hours per week.
- Temporary placement starting at \$17.50/HR.
- Job placement for up to 6 months.
Eligibility: Open to residents of Pinellas counties.

- Up to 5k in tuition assistance

PROGRAM QUALIFIERS:

- 18+ years of age or older.
- Be temporarily or permanently laid off as a consequence of Hurricane Helene or Milton.
- Self-employed and became unemployed or significantly underemployed as a result of recent hurricanes.
- Be eligible as a dislocated worker as defined in WIOA section 3(15)
- Be long-term unemployed workers – unemployed six out of the past 13 weeks.
